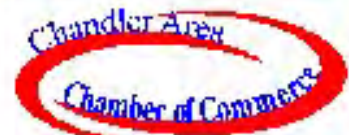
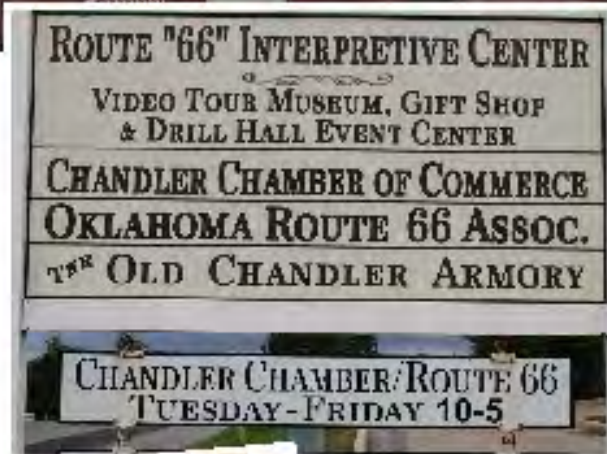

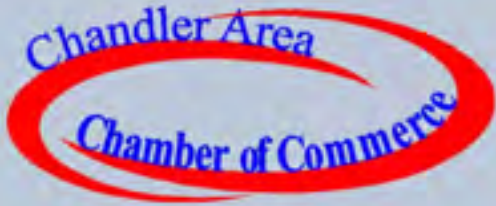

Welcome!

Come discover Chandler.

Chandler is a city in and the county seat of Lincoln County, Oklahoma. It was named after Judge George Chandler, a member of Congress and Assistant Secretary of the Interior.

The site of Chandler was opened by a land run on September 28, 1891. On May 30, 1897, a tornado destroyed most of the fledgling town and killed 19 residents. The courthouse was destroyed by the tornado of 1897, and a two-story frame building was erected as a temporary courthouse on the present site. This building was removed in 1907 to make way for a stone courthouse. This third courthouse burned down on December 23, 1967 and the current courthouse was set in its place and completed in 1969.

Chandler is one of the many cities along the famous U.S. Route 66 and contains a number of attractions to devotees of "The Mother Road." These include The Route 66 Interpretive Center, The Lincoln County Museum of Pioneer History, several Route 66-themed murals, a restored old cottage-style Phillips 66 gas station, and one of the last remaining painted barns advertizing Meramec Caverns, also on Route 66 in Missouri.



One of the world's most famous highways goes right through the middle of Chandler. Here are some Route 66 Trivia facts you may not know.....

- Oklahoma has the most drivable miles of any state Route 66 passes through..... approximately 400 miles.
- Oklahoma has both an Oklahoma Route 66 Museum and a National Route 66 Museum as well as our very own Route 66 Interpretive Center.
- Route 66 crosses 8 states and 3 time zones.
- The "Father of Route 66", Cyrus Avery, was from Tulsa.
- On an original dirt section of Route 66 in Lincoln County between Stroud and Davenport, there is an original obelisk marking the old Ozark Trail.
- Chandler's local lawman Bill Tilghman was killed in what is considered to be the last of the Old West gunfights.
- West of Chandler is one of the few remaining Meramec Caverns barn ads in existence on Route 66.
- Over time, US 66 crossed the railroad in Chandler on three different bridges. Before the 1929 opening of a new bridge (built in 1927), Route 66 turned south onto Cleveland, then west on 4th across an older bridge over the tracks. This bridge was replaced by the current OK 66 structure in 1956.
- Historic H&S Theatre in downtown Chandler was opened in 1926, the same year that US 66 was designated a numbered US highway. It still shows first run movies today.
- Chandler once served the traveling public with several classic motels, including the former Gibson Court and Hurst Lodge. Now only the circa 1939 Lincoln Motel remains from that pre interstate era.

History of the Chandler Area Chamber of Commerce

Chandler Newspaper Article about Chandler Chamber of Commerce September 13, 1956

"The Tuesday noon meeting of the Chandler Chamber of Commerce is a natural occurrence on the weekly agenda of most local civic-minded citizens, but the meeting which was truly of special note was that of Wednesday, August 18, 1899. A crowd met that evening at the court house to arrange for the organization of a commercial club. The meeting was called to order and J.B.A. Robertson (soon to be a state governor) was elected temporary chairman. H.B. Gilstrap was elected secretary.

Remarks were made upon the question of organization by Messrs. Jenness, Harriman, Gilstrap, Hardcastle, Olds, Chandler, Kalkloach.

On motion the chair appointed a committee of three to solicit persons to become members of the commercial club. Those three were R.E. Jenness, Walter Olds, and B.P. Hardcastle.

This was a most important move for all those Chandler citizens. They believed that the prosperity of their town depended upon their success in organizing a commercial club. They wanted to make theirs the best town in Oklahoma, and wished to see Chandler "make the progress which by right of nature and acquired advantages as she is entitled to."

The constitution and by-laws were adopted at the very next meeting, and thus it is the Chandler Chamber of Commerce on August 18, 1956, attained its 57th year of being."

Fast forward.....

March 8, 2011, the Chandler Chamber of Commerce officially becomes Chandler AREA Chamber of Commerce to help not only the City of Chandler, but the surrounding communities.

In 2019, The Chandler Area Chamber of Commerce is still a viable established business organization and is invested in the Chandler community. Economic vitality sustains the quality of life we enjoy in Chandler. We hope to be here another 119 years.....
